Teen Advisory Board is a volunteer program offered at the Waterford Library for teens, ages 12-18 (grades 6th - 12th). We meet throughout the school year to discuss topics of interest and program ideas that appeal to teens, as well as volunteer to assist with library activities and/or event preparation. We are looking for teens who are interested in this opportunity to share your ideas, meet new people, and earn volunteer hours!

Goals and benefits of T.A.B:

The main goal of Teen Advisory Board is to provide an opportunity for teens to voice their ideas, gain volunteer experience, and promote the library and all it offers to other teens your age.

Teen Advisory Board can benefit you in the following ways:
